volume on historic houses put out by the Stanford Historical Society. The first volume was published in 1995 and is out of print, while the second appeared in 1998. More will follow.

The book takes a detailed look at the history behind 17 noteworthy homes built in the San Juan neighborhood of the Stanford campus between 1915 and 1930. At the time, Stanford was going through a moderate housing boom as the university expanded. With new departments opening and new faculty being hired, Stanford was under pressure to come up with additional housing, so the university opened up the southwestern side of campus for construction. The area bounded by Alvarado Row, Campus Drive and Junipero Serra Boulevard was known as San Juan Subdivision 3.

Most of the homes highlighted in the book were built by three prominent Palo Alto architects of the day: Birge Clark, Charles Sumner, and John Branner. This period in architecture was known as "eclectic" and the houses in this volume live up to that name. Homes of very different styles — Spanish eclectic, English cottage, Italian Renaissance, and French country — all went up within a few blocks of each other. The differences in designs can be seen in the great sketches




Portuguse tiles inside 1040 Campus Drive depict a monk in a wine cellar.

and old photographs included in the book, which show off the houses both inside and out. The book also traces renovations made over the years as the houses were passed on from one family to the next.

The volume begins with three Tudor-style homes on El Escarpado Way, all of which were designed by Sumner. The houses were built on a quiet cul-de-sac circling an old California oak. The street soon earned the nickname "Biz Hill," since most of the houses were owned by faculty from the new business school.

The house at 445 El Escarpado Way was originally built for J. Hugh Jackson, a professor of accounting, at a cost of \$28,000. The house has all of the classic Tudor elements: beige stucco walls, timbered exteriors and steeply-pointed roofs. But it also has touches that are uniquely "Stanford." There are built-in file cabinets and card catalog drawers in the first-floor library, the Stanford "tree" is carved into the sconces beside the fireplace, and inside the gun cabinet is a replica of the Ax. This was also the house where Frederick Terman, the famed engineering professor and provost, lived for many years with his wife Sybil. After her death, Terman donated the house to the uni-



This month's picks by Frank Sanchez, head book buyer at Kepler's Books, is an all-fiction list, including a Pulitizer-Prize winner, a Rick Bass novel, and a heartfelt and beautifully written novel about love.

"The Diezmo" by Rick Bass is a novel set during the days of the Texas Republic. The story is about an ill-fated military expedition to Mexico which turns bloody in a slaughter by rogue soldiers, who are later captured and imprisoned. Bass is the author of the nonfiction "Caribou Rising" and of the story collection "The Her-

mit's Story."

"Gilead" by Marilynne **Robinson** is the 2005 Pulitizer-Prize winning novel, by the author of the acclaimed "Housekeeping" more than 20 years ago. In this story, a dying minister leaves a farewell letter to his son. Sanchez said this is a "deep and beautiful book." This is Robinson's second novel, although she has also published two nonfiction books.

""The History of Love" by Nicole Krauss is a novel about an elderly World War II survivor who had written a now-lost novel, "The History of Love." The story carries the plot lines of both fictional books forward, intertwining the characters. It's a touching story of love and

loss.
"Pinkerton's Sister" by Peter Rushforth is a novel about a young woman who stays in the attic of her family home, reading the classics and confounding family members, who think she should be seeking a spouse. The novel is set in 1905 New York.

"Chuck Dugan AWOL" by Eric Chase An**derson** is a novel with maps, and a hoot of a story. The author, who is the brother of filmmaker Wes Anderson, has written a lively little story about an 18-year-old dropout from the Naval Academy at Annapolis who goes on a journey to keep his mother from marrying his deceased father's arch enemy. Along the way, he also has to find the treasure his father buried for him. The maps help tell the story

"Misfortune" by Wesley Stace is a novel by the musician known as John Wesley Harding (he is writing under his real name). The story is about a boy raised as a girl in 19th century England, creating some confusion for the child, especially when puberty hits.

The volume also features a number of houses designed by Birge Clark. Clark grew up in Palo Alto and made his career here. He is credited with having had a hand in the design of 450 buildings in Palo Alto. His Spanish eclectic designs the stucco-like walls, tile roofs, iron grilles and arches - have come to define Palo Alto. And yet the most interesting Birge Clark house included in this book bears little resemblance to his trademark

Clark built the house at 548 Gerona Road for a friend. The two squirrels he has drawn into the architectural plans are suggestive of the spirit in which it was built. The writers of the book uneasily classify the design as "Tudor period style" and then go on to describe the house as "picturesque with elements of simplified Gothic revival and medieval cottage." They also note that the original homeowner, Graham Stuart, paid his way through college playing the nick-elodeon for silent movies. This seems to be a telling detail given that the house looks less like something out of real life and more like it belongs in the Adventures of Robin Hood or along the road to Camelot.

The windows are oddly-shaped, the front door is wooden and heavy and curved into a point at the top. Steep-pitched roofs and gables of different heights jut out from all sides, and the cedar-shingled roofs are curved and joined together at funny angles, giving it the sunken and aged quality of a fairy-tale cot-

The house Allardice and Campbell built next to their oak tree could not have been more different. The style of their house is described as Italian Renaissance eclectic. It is formal and stately with wrought-iron grilles accenting the windows and ornate pillars and archways lining the patio out back. Before moving to this house, Allardice and Campbell had lived with two other professors in a house on 33 Alvarado Row where they had started a club called "The Bachelors.'

It was a club that Allardice and Campbell would, unofficially at least, belong to for the rest of their lives. Architect Walter H. Ratcliff Jr. designed the house so each of them would have their own separate "chamber" with a bedroom and bathroom. Allardice planted an elaborate garden replete with fig and almond trees and as many as 250 plants and bulbs from around the world, and they settled in for a permanent stay. Both men would live in the house until their deaths: Allardice in 1928 and Campbell — who by then was the last of the pioneer Stanford facul-– in 1954. ■








The most fundamental skill

When seventh grader Juan Carlos entered YES Reading last fall, his reading skills were only at a fourth grade level. 5 months later, he was reading the same texts as his seventh grade peers without difficulty. Twice a week, Juan Carlos attended YES Reading and received one-on-one tutoring attention from trained volunteer tutors. This individualized support helped Juan Carlos gain three grade levels in his reading ability and gave him self-confidence and a love of reading that he never thought possible.

YES Reading recruits and trains community volunteers to provide one-to-one tutoring support for students reading significantly below grade level. In order to facilitate a relationship between students' school, community, and home experiences, YES Reading locates its Reading Centers directly on school campuses. YES Reading currently operates one Reading Center on

the Belle Haven School campus in east Menlo Park, CA. A second Reading Center is scheduled to open at Selby Lane School in the Redwood City School District in the fall of 2004.

In the 2003-2004 school year, more than 60 dedicated volunteers provided tutoring to almost 100 students at YES Reading's Belle Haven Center. Ninety percent of these students improved their reading skills significantly, some by as much as five grade levels. In the past three years, YES Reading has helped more than 100 students achieve on grade level reading abilities.

According to Belle Haven classroom teachers, 95% of YES Reading students also improved in the areas of attentiveness, self-confidence, positive attitude, homework completion, and overall interest in reading. "YES Reading is about more than reading," says Donna Largent, Belle Haven Program Coordinator. "We are also building students' self-esteem and helping them to have a more positive outlook on school and their future"

A current YES Reading student, Sonia Barrera, explains why YES Reading is so helpful to students. "Most [YES Reading students] didn't like to read before they came to YES Reading, mostly because they weren't that good at it. But YES Reading showed us that reading could be fun, and our tutors helped us to realize that read-

ing would make a better future for us."

Barrera added, "My tutor is so much more than just a tutor for me. She is like a friend."

YES Reading is looking forward to bringing the same level of success that it has generated at Belle Haven to Selby Lane School this fall. Selby Lane is the first of several planned YES Reading expansion sites around the Bay Area.

"Bringing YES Reading to Selby Lane will offer the students of that school community the same opportunities and achieve-

ments that we have afforded the students of Belle Haven," says Almy. "We are very excited to partner with Selby Lane and join the efforts already underway on the campus to help make Selby Lane a great school."

The types of activities to be funded by the levy of an assessment against businesses within the District are the promotion of public events which benefit businesses in the area and which take place on or in public places within the District; the furnishing of music in any public place in the District: and activities which benefit businesses located and operating in the District.

SECTION 8. New businesses established in the District after the beginning of any fiscal year shall be exempt from the levy of the assessment for that fiscal year. In addition, non-profit organizations, newspapers and professional "single-person businesses," defined as those businesses which have 25% or less full time equivalent employees, including the business owner, shall be exempt from the
